The Christmas Store takes place the two weekends before Christmas. This is an opportunity for residents in the Parker Street neighborhood to purchase gifts for their children at a fraction of the retail price. All of the toys and gifts are donated by individuals, churches and civic organizations within the Lakeland community.

A total of **130 volunteers** donated their time to run the Christmas Store, which sold a total of **1,120 gifts** to **68 neighborhood families**, all of whom fulfilled the requirements for the mandatory pre-registration. Gifts offered included infant & toddler toys, dolls, sports equipment, electronics and much more. ***Thanks to the 2008 Christmas store, 187 Parker Street children experienced the joy of opening gifts on Christmas morning.***
