Taking Victory to the Streets First Ever eAuction!

Taking Victory to the Streets is a collaborative fundraiser to benefit Parker Street Ministries and Desire Street Ministries (Danny Wuerffel's ministry) which operates out of Atlanta, GA. This event is unique in that the proceeds are split to benefit both ministries. Despite several changes along the way (including speaker, venue & format!), the event took place on April 23, 2009.

Approximately 80 people attended the reception at Lone Palm Golf Club. Danny Wuerffel and Tim Mitchell shared their hearts regarding their work with these ministries, and afterwards guests mingled with these two directors as well as Parker Street Ministries' staff and members of the Board of Trustees. The scaled-down reception was a fun and energetic celebration of the work God is doing through these two fine ministries.

Proceeds from this event resulted in program funding of \$42,800 for Desire Street Ministries and \$175,000+ for Parker Street Ministries. **For every \$1 raised, 96 cents directly supports these urban ministries' programs. WOW!**

Summer Camp

The Parker Street Ministries Summer Camp begins June 15 and continues through August 14. Summer Camp is for children living in the Parker Street neighborhood, and runs every weekday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Parker Street Ministries' staff engages the children in a wide variety of activity including academic enrichment, field trips to places like the bowling alley and the museum, arts and crafts led by teachers from the Polk Museum of Art and lessons in other extracurricular activities such as sports and cooking. The camp is of a minimal cost to parents, and is funded by various sources including The Community Foundation of Greater Lakeland, a neighborhood matching fund grant from the City of Lakeland and The Polk Museum of Art, individual donors and local churches.
